

ST Electronics bags another Defence Technology Prize



ST Electronics was awarded the Defence Technology Prize (DTP) 2008 for Team Engineering. This prize was awarded jointly to its subsidiary, ST Electronics (Info-Software Systems), the Defence Science & Technology Agency and the Republic of Singapore Air Force, whose members formed the Air Power Generation Command and Control Information System team. The prize was presented by Singapore's Minister for Defence Teo Chee Hean on 7 November 2008.

The Air Power Generation Command and Control Information System team provides the Airforce with necessary critical information to deploy its resources to support the forces. The joint team designed a computer program to handle the complex combat service support information needs. The system is capable of instantly calculating the number of officers as well as the kind of support that are needed.

The DTP, a national level award, is Singapore Ministry of Defence's most prestigious award given in recognition of outstanding contributions in defence science and technology that enhances Singapore's defence capability. It serves to motivate excellence in defence science and technology and is presented annually. This is ST Electronics (Info-Software Systems)'s fifth award.
